3. Minutes of the meeting of 30th March 2026

7. Display boards on local history

The Clerk had looked on the internet and found that a great many companies could supply boards. Councillors were also impressed with the use of QR codes on boards and other sites as a means of giving information on an area's history etc.

The Clerk would speak to one of these companies to get an approximate cost for 5 boards plus a QR code option.

In the meantime, Councillors would start to consider content.

The County Councillor had circulated a number of emails with updates on roads. The Clerk was asked to follow up on the proposed footpath and the litter bin, both in Pentre Llanrhaeadr.

Cllr Elfed Williams had also been asked if a map of current and planned road repairs was available.

The Clerk reminded Councillors to keep on putting road defects on Denbighshire's 360 degrees system, copying in Cllr Williams.

None. However, it was noted that that The Council had still not had a response from the Planning Department of Denbighshire County Council about the flagrant breach of planning regulations at the Paddock, Saron.

It was proposed that the Chair would write again to the Planning department urging enforcement on this site. This email would provide a template for other Councillors to do likewise.
